October 16, 2017 – The Haverhill Board of Assessors, in accordance with the Bureau of Local Assessment Guidelines, urge the local property owners to verify that their now Fiscal Year 2018 property assessment data is accurate during the State mandated period of Public Disclosure from October 16, 2017 thru October 24, 2017.

The Massachusetts Department of Revenue has conducted an extensive review of the new values and preliminary certification of all property values has been approved. It is now recommended that all property owners also check the data on their property <http://haverhill.patriotproperties.com>. Residents can also verify this data in person by visiting the Assessor's Office located at City Hall 4 Summer Street Room #115.

All values are based on Sales and/or income and expenses for calendar year 2016 as required by Massachusetts state law.

The Public disclosure period will run for 7 days as recommended by the Department of Revenue. The Haverhill Board of Assessors advised all taxpayers to contact the Assessor's Office with any questions during the Public Disclosure period (October 16, 2017 thru October 24, 2017). The Assessors also have information on the Appeals process, Tax Exemptions, Tax maps and Taxpayers forms.

The Assessor's Office hours are Monday thru Friday 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM except holidays.
